3. **Reduced fee:** NAWDP provides a \$25.00 discount off the application fee as a result of this reciprocity agreement with Dynamic Works.
4. **Dynamic Works Reciprocity:** Dynamic Works also offers reciprocity to NAWDP members who have the CWDP credential. If you are a current CWDP, you also have a streamlined way to receive your Dynamic Works' Core Skills Workforce Professional certificate. To receive your Dynamic Works' certification, you must take and pass the Core Skills certification exam. Dynamic Works offers a \$25 discount off the certification exam price or a \$95.00 discount off the entire training and certification package price for current NAWDP CWDP's.
